Dear Authors and Readers of Oil Shale,

I am happy to present you the new number of the journal Oil Shale. I hope you will enjoy reading it and find a lot of useful information for yourself in this issue. Below I would like to pay the contributors' attention to some important requirements to be met when submitting a manuscript to Oil Shale.

Authors are asked to follow that the volume of their manuscript, including Abstract, figures, tables and References list, should not exceed 15 pages, but maximum 20 pages (the volume of one page is max 3300 characters with spaces).

Please do not forget to send the Executive Editor a filled-in Copyright Transfer Form together with the submitted manuscript. You can easily find a copy of the Form on our homepage at <http://www.kirj.ee/public/copyright.pdf>

It is essential that your paper should be written in clear, proper English. Manuscripts requiring substantial improvement of the English language may be subject to returning to the authors for revision before the reviewing process. If English is not your native language, please ask a native English speaker to read over your manuscript before submitting.

Figures should be submitted in required format (TIFF, BMP, XCL or CDR). The Editorial Office may reject figures presented in file formats other than mentioned above, or that are of low quality. Figures should fit in the printed page (the maximum typing area of the journal is 120 mm x 200 mm). Each figure must be clearly numbered. Do not submit coloured figures if they are meant to be published in black-and-white. Coloured figures can be accepted if this is relevant for your presentation. In this case, the authors will be asked to cover the costs of colour printing.

Literature sources used in preparing the manuscript and referred to should be summarized in the text as shortly, concisely and informatively as possible. They have to appear in an appropriate place in the text and must be equipped with consecutive numbers in squared brackets. The reference numbers in the text should match those in the References list to be presented at the end of your paper. Please indicate titles of journals in the list of References in abbreviated form.
